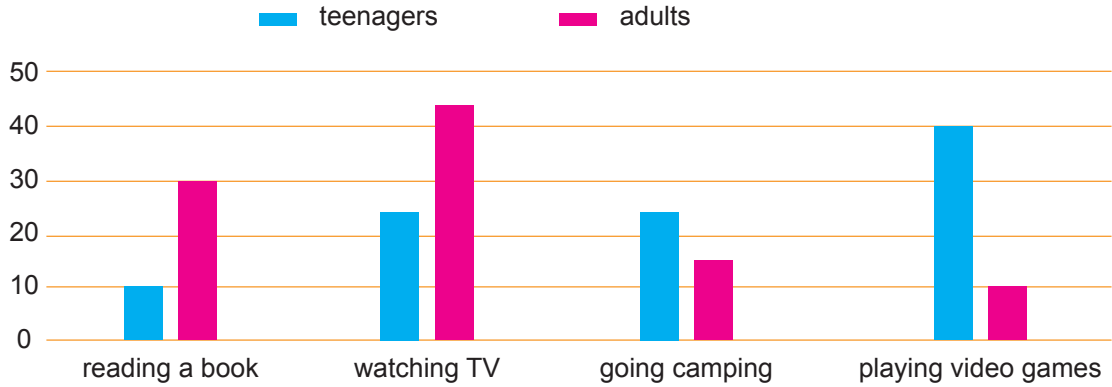

- Some spices and salt
- 500 g mince
- 2 peppers
- 1 tbs. of flour
- 2 onions
- 2 glasses of milk
- 2 tbs. of butter

*Recipe*

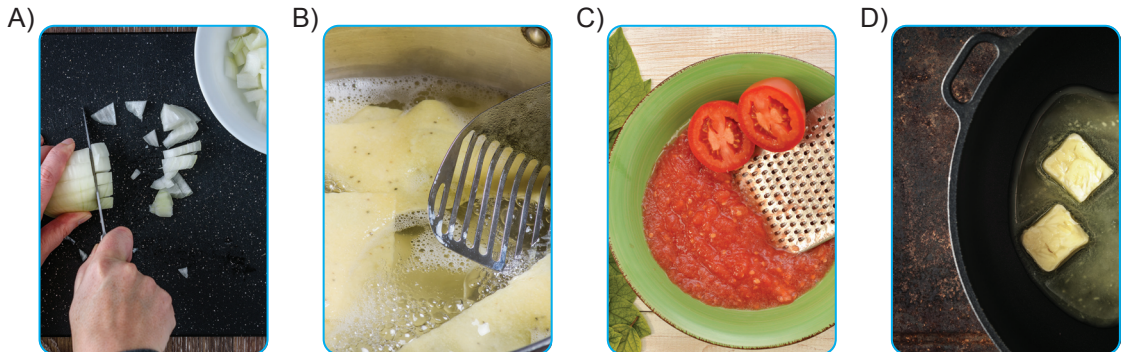
- First, dice the onions and fry them in a large pan until they get soft.
- Second chop the peppers and add them into to the pan.
- Then, add the mince and cook until they all get brown.
- Next, grate the tomatoes and put them into the pan, stir for 3 minutes. Add some spices and salt.
- After that, prepare your béchamel sauce. Melt some butter in a sauce pan and add the flour. Stir for a while and pour the milk. Stir continuously until it boils.
- In a large baking tray, place 6 sheets of lasagna and pour some of your mince mixture and béchamel sauce on the sheets. Repeat the previous step four times. Make sure that you cover them well.
- Preheat the oven to 200 °C and bake it for 30 minutes.

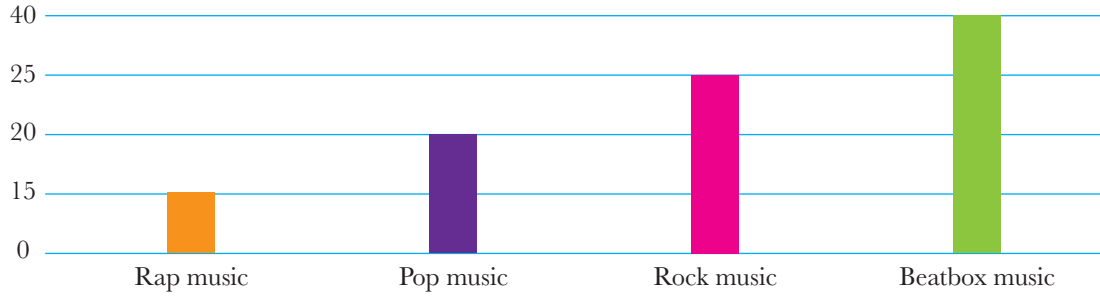

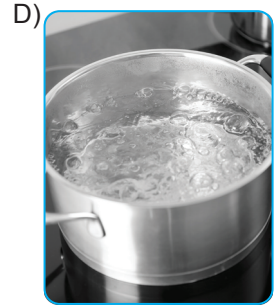
